In our continuing effort to be a good neighbor and to establish a reasonable balance between those who need and enjoy music and those who are annoyed by it, we requested that the Town of Tainter establish an ordinance that clearly defines when outdoor live music is allowed. We have always abided by the agreement reached a few years ago about ending all outdoor live music by 11 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday nights. We are willing to agree to an ordinance that would end outdoor live music at 1 AM on Friday and Saturday nights even though that is well before closing time, and urge the Township to approve it so all parties know the balance that has been struck. **WE SUPPORT AN ORDINANCE WITH THESE TIMES!**

In 2008, the Tainter Town Board voted to renew the music agreement and specifically allow outdoor music until 1 AM on Friday and Saturday nights. We will strictly abide by these times.

A few new residents to our area feel these hours are **TOTALLY UNACCEPTABLE** and are still trying to **KILL THE MUSIC ON TAINTER LAKE**. If the bands must stop playing at an earlier time, say 11 pm on weekends (when most of the people do not come out until after 10 pm) we will not be able to afford to hire great bands like Trick Pony, Neal McCoy, Little River Band and Sawyer Brown. This is exactly what these chronic complainers are counting on, if it is not profitable for us to have bands, there will be no bands.
